# Weathering COVID-19

Just as God has provided for you, so you have provided for the needs of our parish. Your investment is like the tilling of the soil, helping us to grow stronger. Despite the pandemic, our parish offertory remained strong, primarily due to your generosity; but it was greatly assisted by online giving and a record-breaking Diocesan Lenten Appeal.

As I am sure you can imagine, our parish, and particularly our societies, suffered from the loss of fundraising monies during this past year. Many events had to be cancelled or postponed due to the pandemic. Our very popular fall craft show has also unfortunately been cancelled again for this year. Hopefully, circumstances will allow us to plan parish events for the near future that would invite our participation.

I do want to call your attention to an important ongoing initiative here in our parish that certainly requires the support of all of us. This is our parish faith formation program which had to become innovative last year because of pandemic restrictions. Our staff developed a very successful "monthly drive thru" program where families picked up their guided family activities for each month. This was a program that included all family members in the process of faith formation. This year we hope to return to a more traditional program, but one that will have to maintain a flexibility due to continuing concerns over the pandemic.

These important efforts will go a long way toward planting the seeds of faith in the next generation of our parish.
