



THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT PASTOR'S REFLECTION

March 3. Texts: Exodus 20:1-17, Psalm: 19:8, 9, 10, 11, 1 Corinthians 1:22-25, John 2:13-25

Spring Cleaning. How do we understand today's Gospel passage about the cleansing of the Temple? Filled with zeal for the House of His Father, the Temple, Jesus makes a whip of cord and drives the money changers sitting at their counters for they had turned the Temple into a market. Had they crossed the line in the Temple courtyard and entered the sacred precincts of the Temple itself turning it into a market place thus disregarding and disrespecting the sanctity and sacredness of the Temple which was the House of God His Father?

Jesus Himself the Son of God, the new Temple, demonstrates thus His authority to represent and reveal God's Temple. When asked for a sign to justify His action, Jesus refers His own Body as the sanctuary which, when destroyed, He would raise up in three days, a veiled reference to His death and resurrection.

Lent is a time to do some spiritual spring cleaning. If Jesus were to enter our homes, what would He drive away and dispel? We need to clean our own homes and our hearts; to drive out zealously all that desecrates them. Our homes are "domestic Churches" and our hearts are Temples of God. It is in our homes and in our hearts that genuine worship takes place; that faith is born and nourished; that we must let Jesus enter and cleanse us.
